

# May 2026 BCcupms Website Coordinator Report

## Format and content changes:

Very little has changed on the website this year. I have added links to the Kangaroo and Math Challengers contests and kept up with minor updates to institutional representatives and meeting history. Most updates to the site happen in the weeks leading up to the annual meeting, when agendas and planning information is being made available.

Last year, I added a Members Forum page and created a sample post to demonstrate the blog format that is available on WordPress. I haven't touched it since, and there was talk at the last meeting as to whether to use the website or use a BCCAT-hosted Moodle site instead.

I have also added the latest revision of the website policy to the footer of the website. I believe this policy still needs to be formally approved by the committee.

## Proposed changes:

Since the 2025 meeting, I have successfully created a very basic Moodle course on the [BCCAT-hosted site](#). Members should be able to create an account and request access to the Mathematics & Statistics articulation page. Currently this Moodle course only contains a tab for discussion forums and a tab for file sharing. If the committee would like to use this page, then it would be beneficial to limit its use to purposes that are not already fulfilled by the main BCCUPMS website.

One additional change that I would like to propose for 2027 is to switch the institutional report from a Google form to one that is natively run in our website. This would allow for users to submit a report without needing a Google account.

## Financial report:

I continue to fund the website expenses personally, with reimbursement from donations of committee members. There are two annual expenses, totalling \$84.62: \$67.20 for WordPress Personal plan and \$17.42 for the domain.

The generous donations from 2025 have already covered \$27.99 of this year's expenses, with a balance of \$56.63 owing in 2026. The [website funding report](#) has been updated with a history of transactions since 2022. A link to this year's [PayPal fundraiser](#) is also available from the 2026 report.

As always, I welcome any feedback or suggestions from other members on the new site design. Please let me know if any information is inaccurate or out-of-date.
